# eSIM, it's easier than you think!

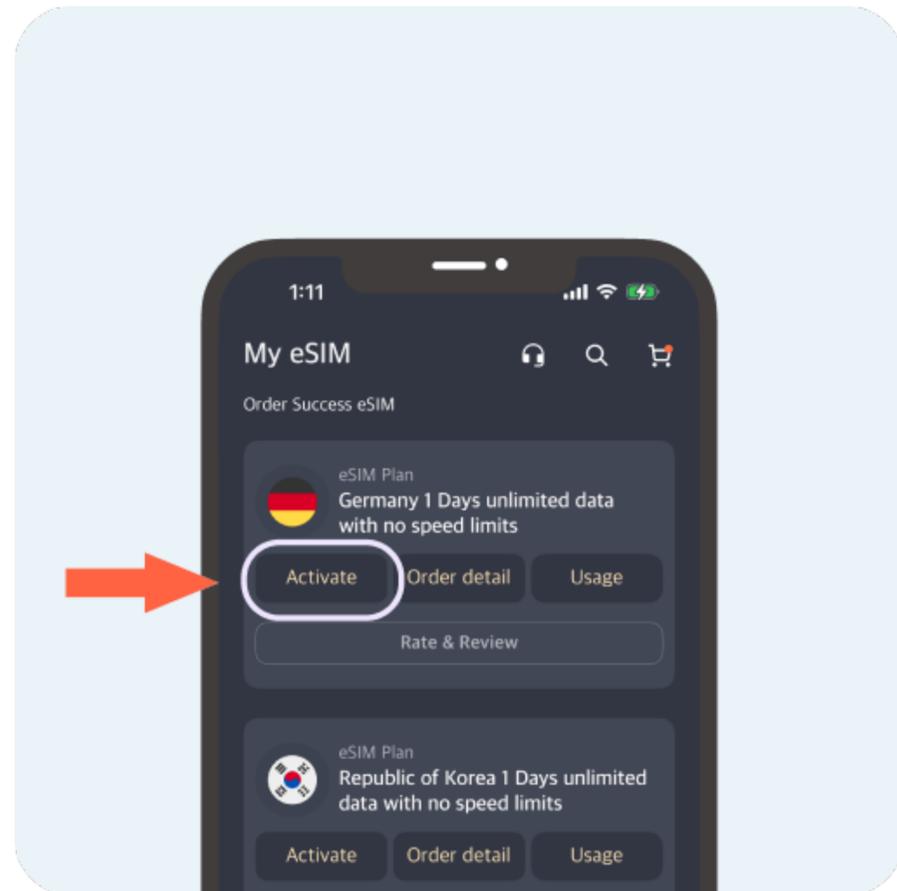
Anyone can easily setting(install)

3. Setting for **local use** in destination country

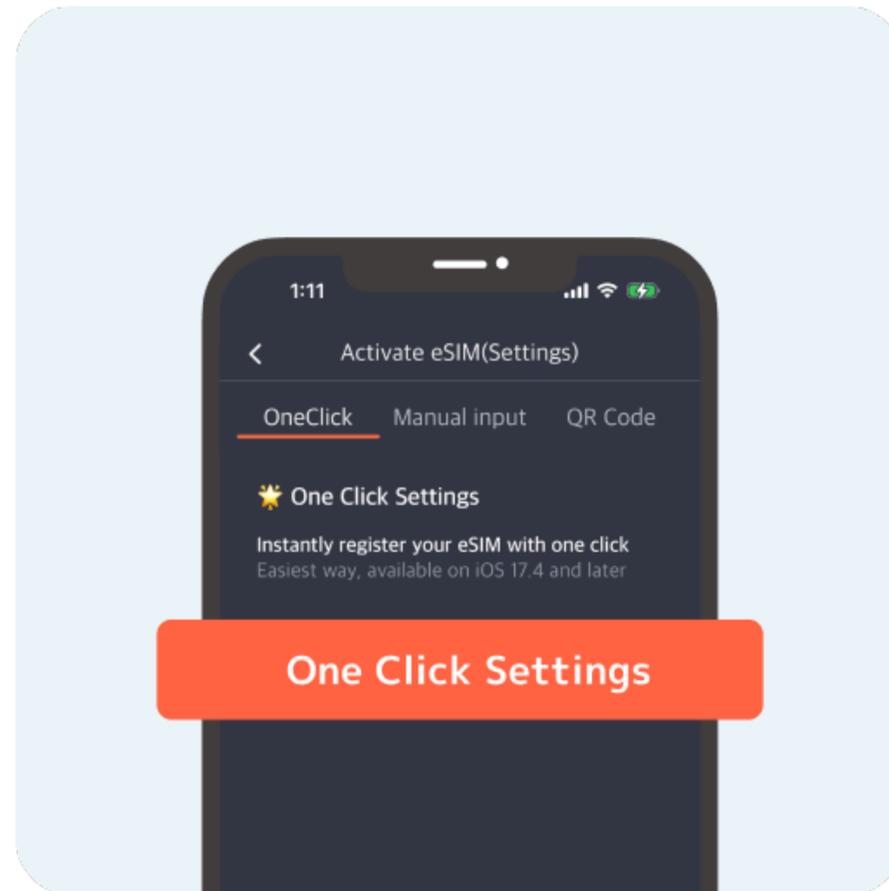
# 1. Activate (Install) eSIM

- 1. One Click Settings
- 2. Manually Input(copy & paste)
- 3. QR Code Scan

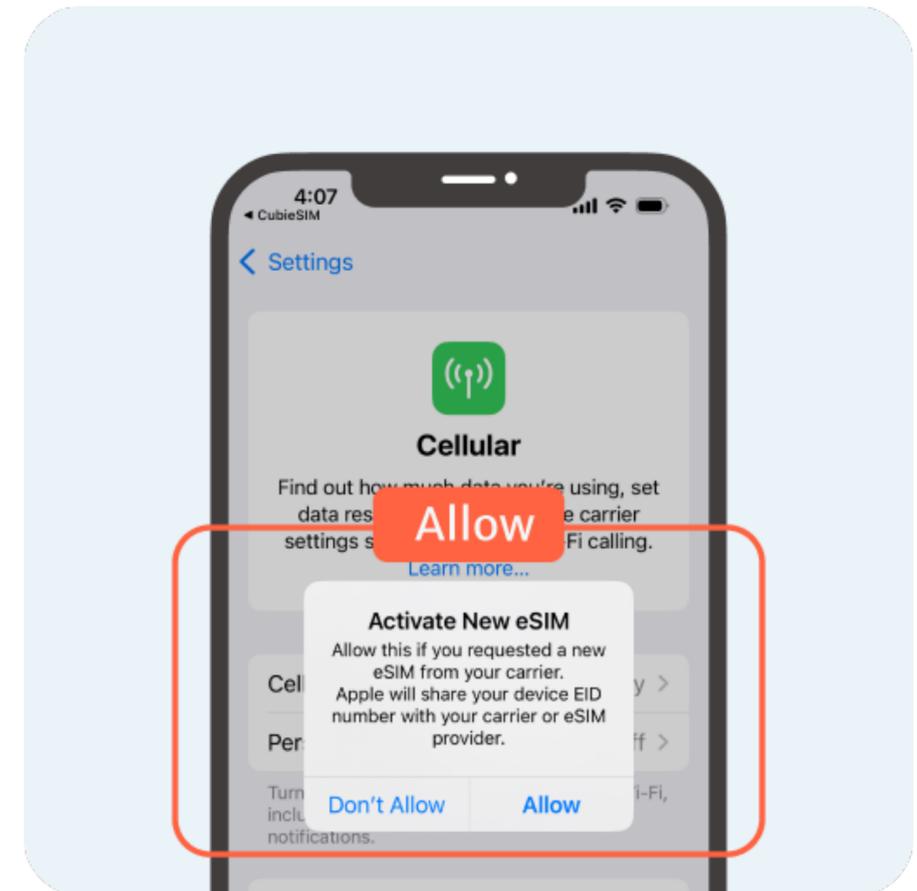
# 1. One Click Settings



My eSIM Tab > Activate Button



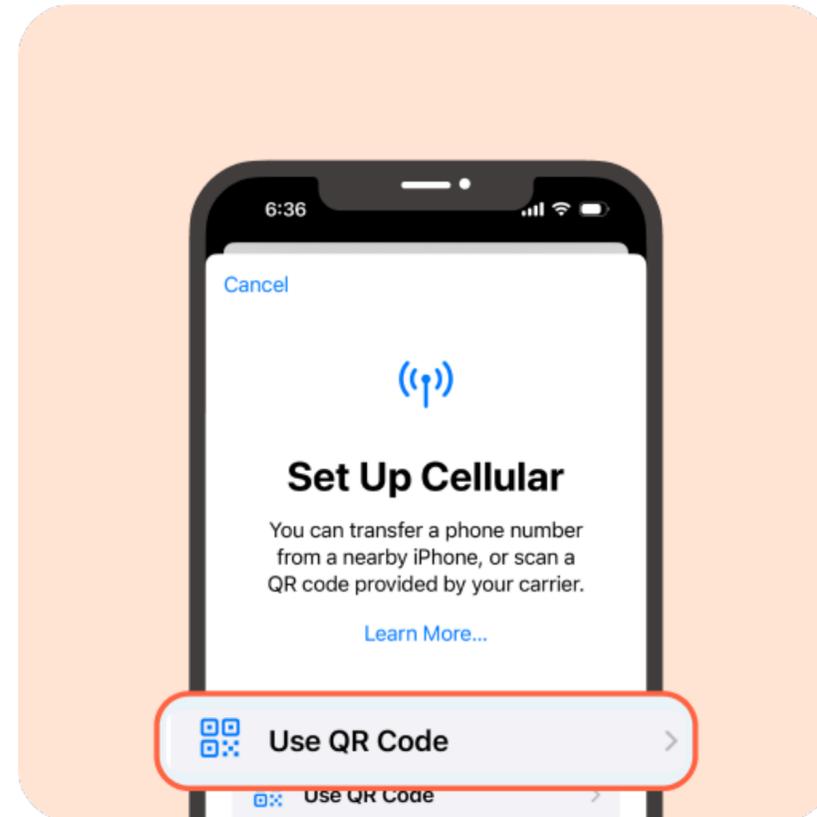
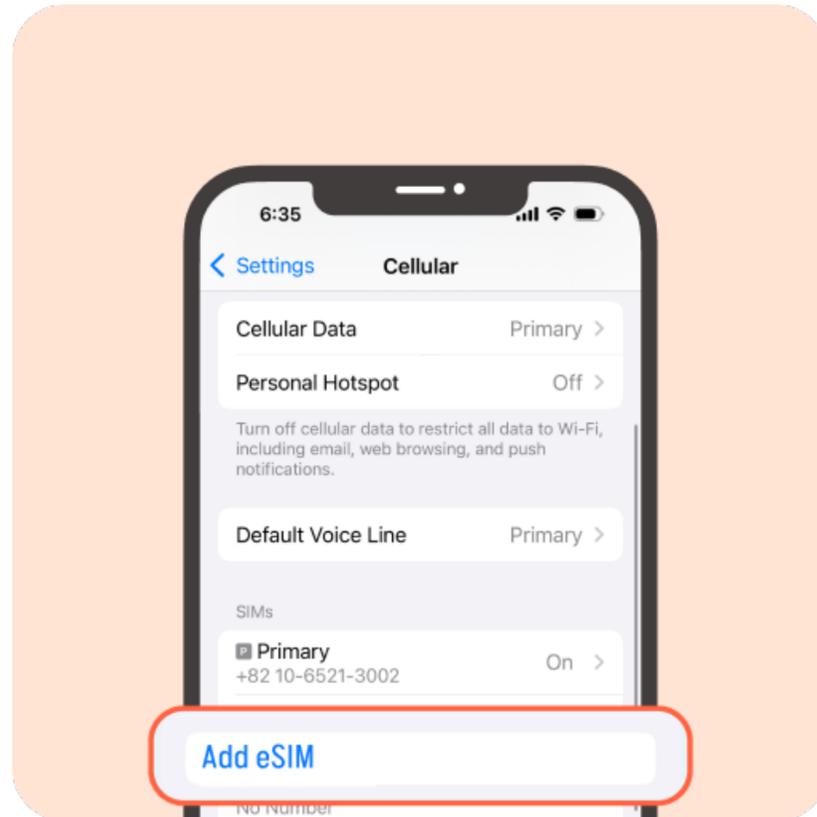
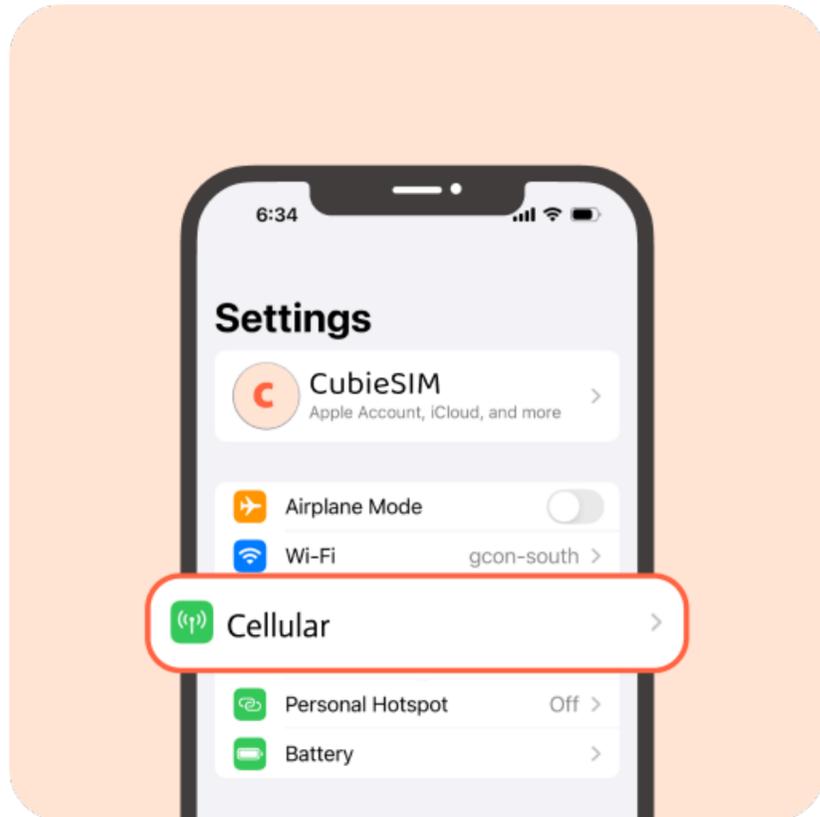
Press the 'One Click Settings' button to move to the setting screen, where automatic activation will take place.

## 2. Manually Input(copy & paste)

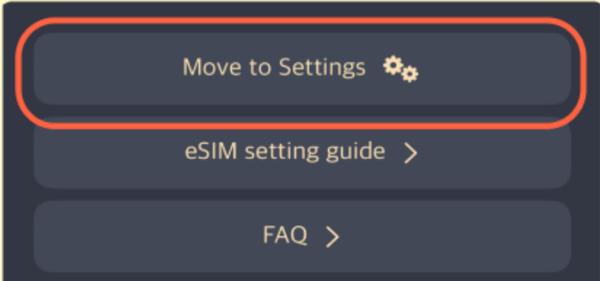
Settings > Cellular > Add eSIM > Use QR Code



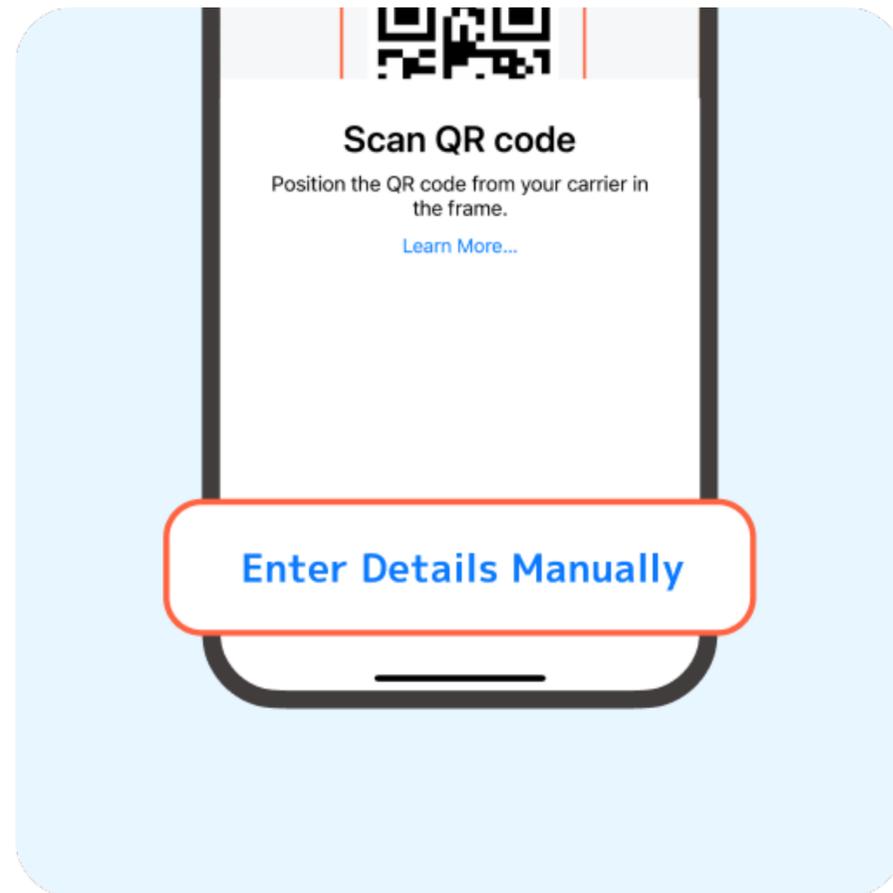
The screen may appear differently depending on your iOS version.

**Tip** Even when using the Manual Input (copy and paste) method, you must first select 'Use QR Code' to proceed.

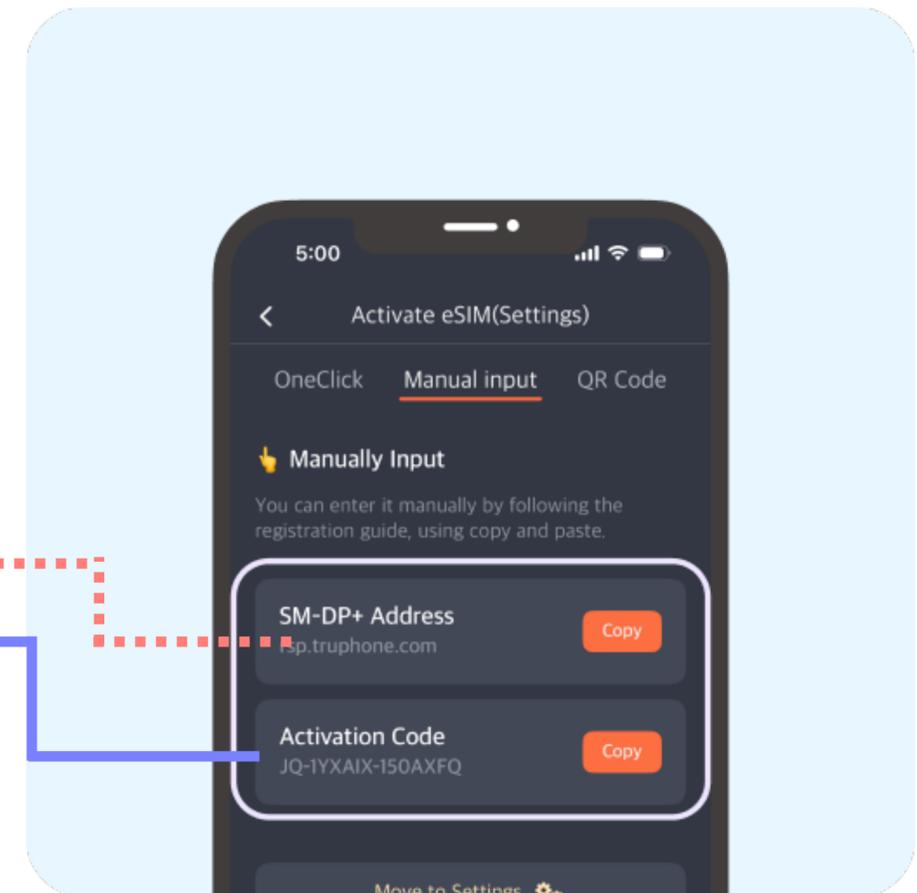
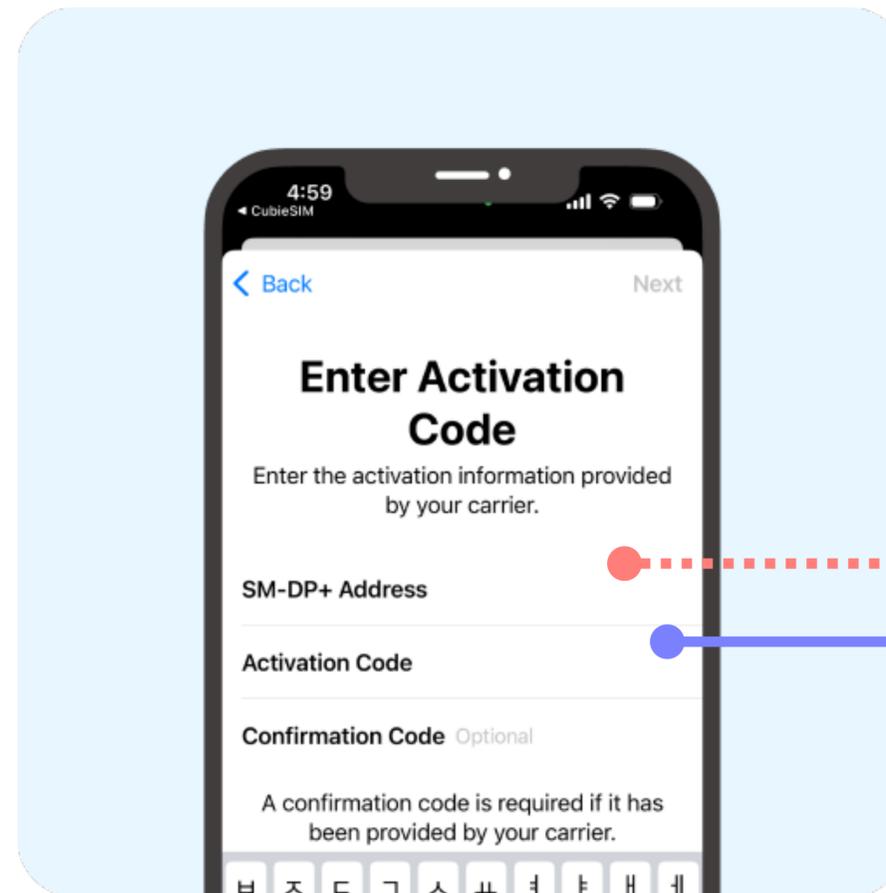
**Tip** Try using the 'Move to Settings' button.  
(My eSIM tab > Activate > 'Move to Settings' button)

## 2. Manually Input(copy & paste)



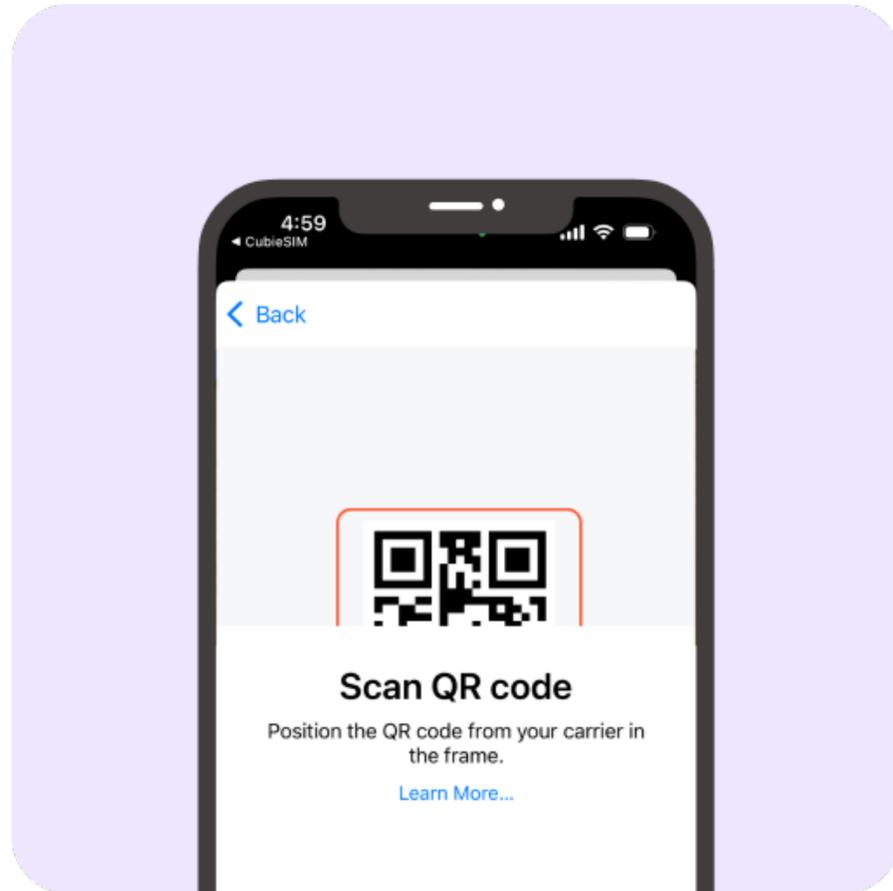
The button can be found at the **bottom of the screen**



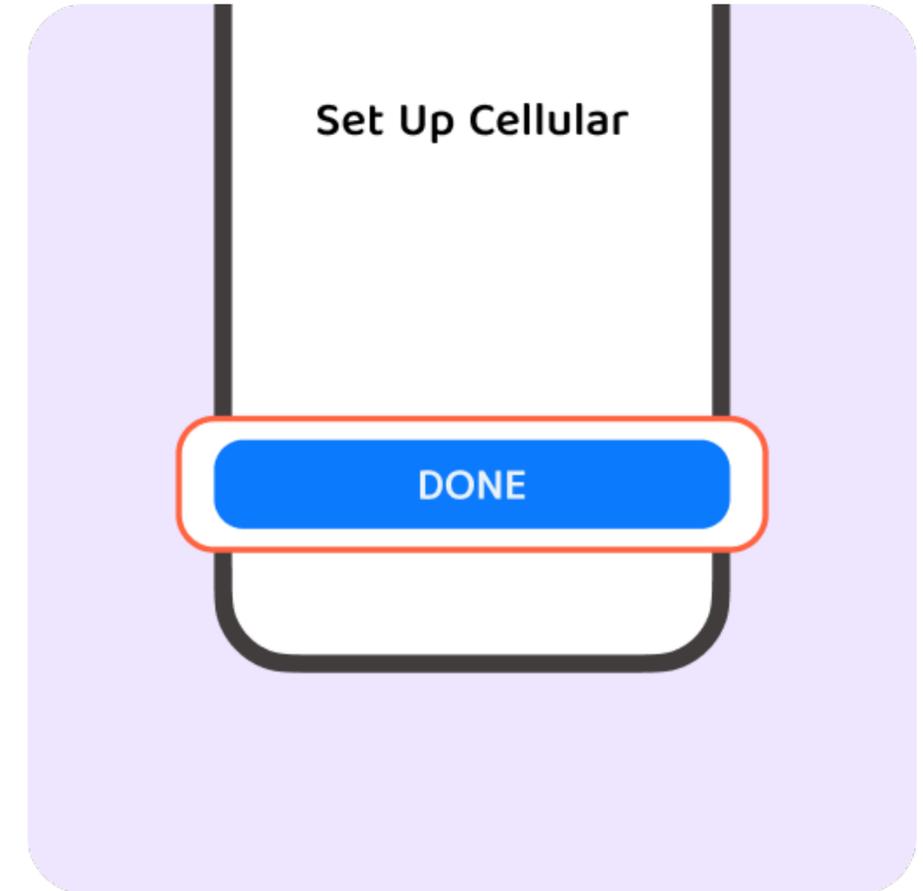
The **SM-DP+ address** goes into the **SM-DP+**, **Activation code** goes into the **Activation code**

### 3. QR Code Scan

Settings > Cellular > Add eSIM > Use QR Code



Simply scan the QR code in the **camera area** displayed on the screen.



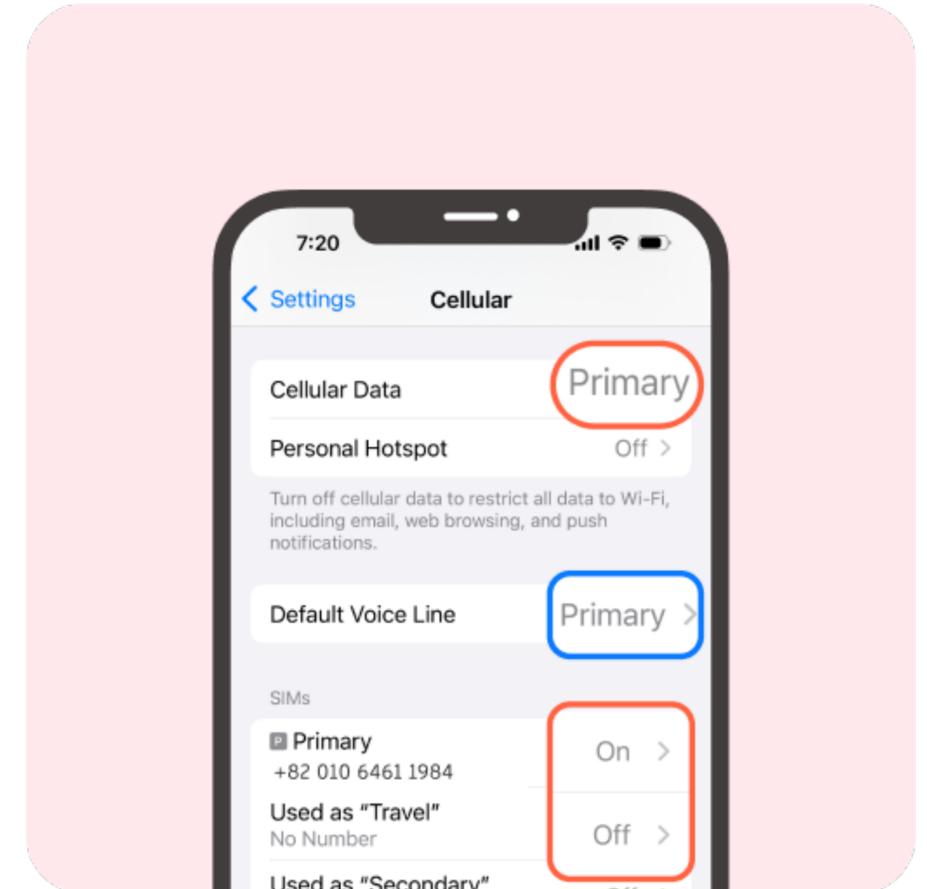
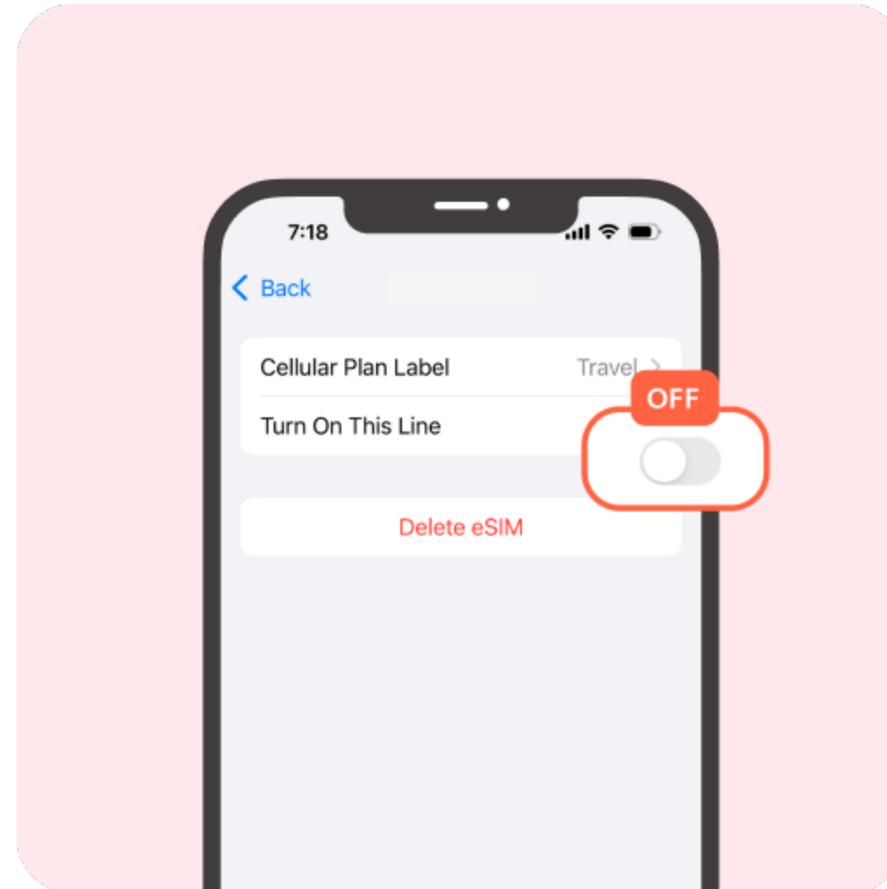
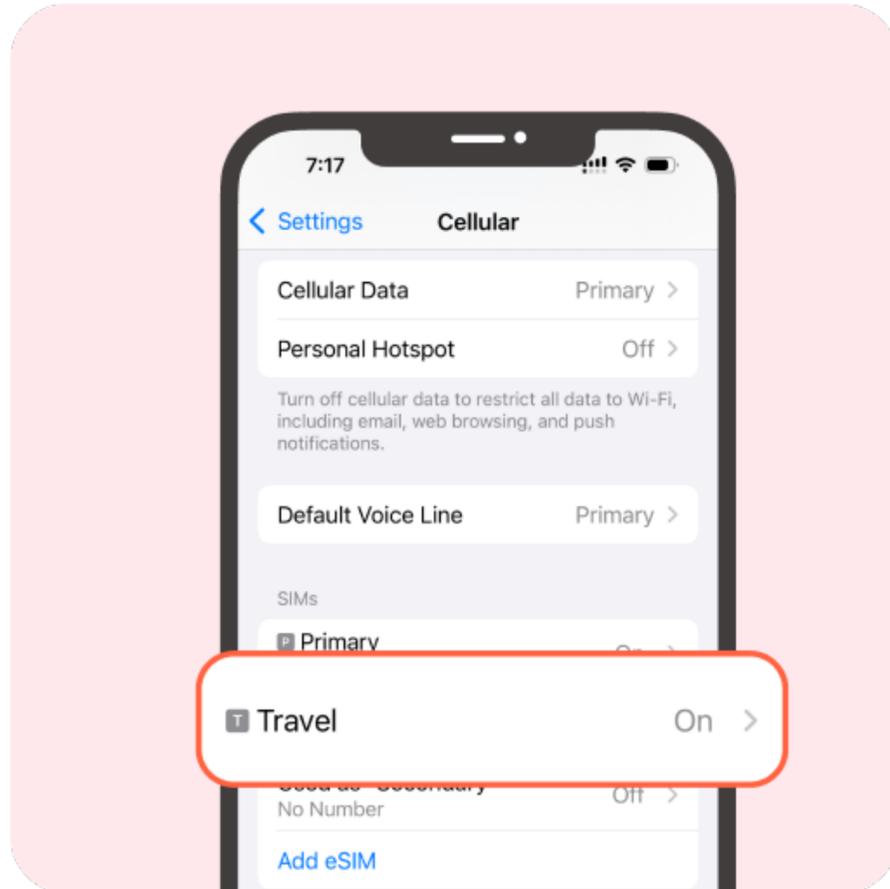
If scanning on the screen is difficult, please use

## 2. Setting Confirm(in Home Country)

- Check if the eSIM has been successfully registered.
- Not using the eSIM now
- Before departure

## Settings in home country

(Primary - Primary - On - Off)



A new eSIM named 'Travel' has been added.

The SIM referred to as 'Primary' is the current plan SIM being used in your home country.

### Tip

#### Is eSIM NAME other than 'Travel'?

The eSIM name can be set arbitrarily. Feel free to assign a name that distinguishes it from your primary plan.

Ex) Travel\_With\_CubieSIM

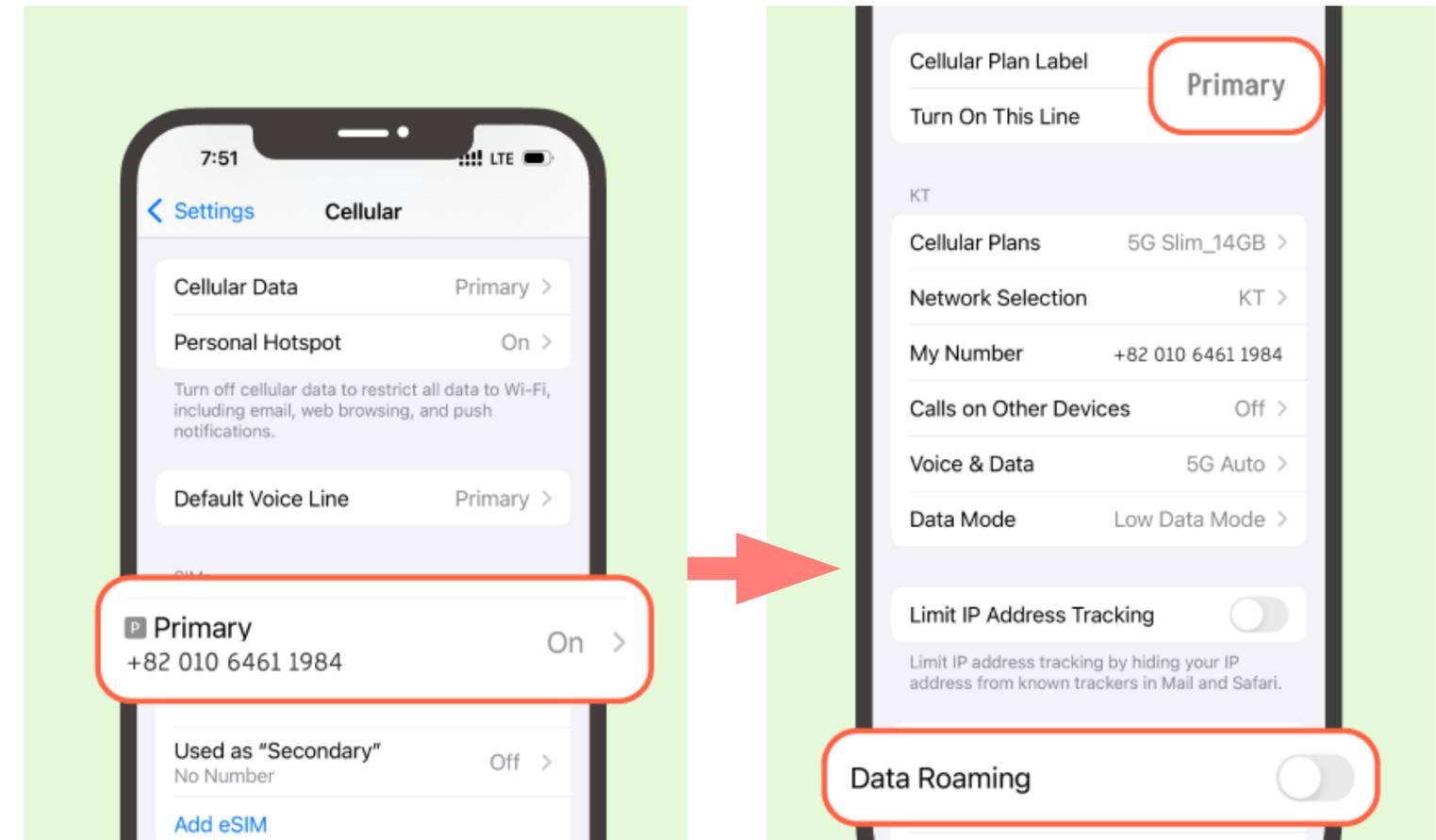
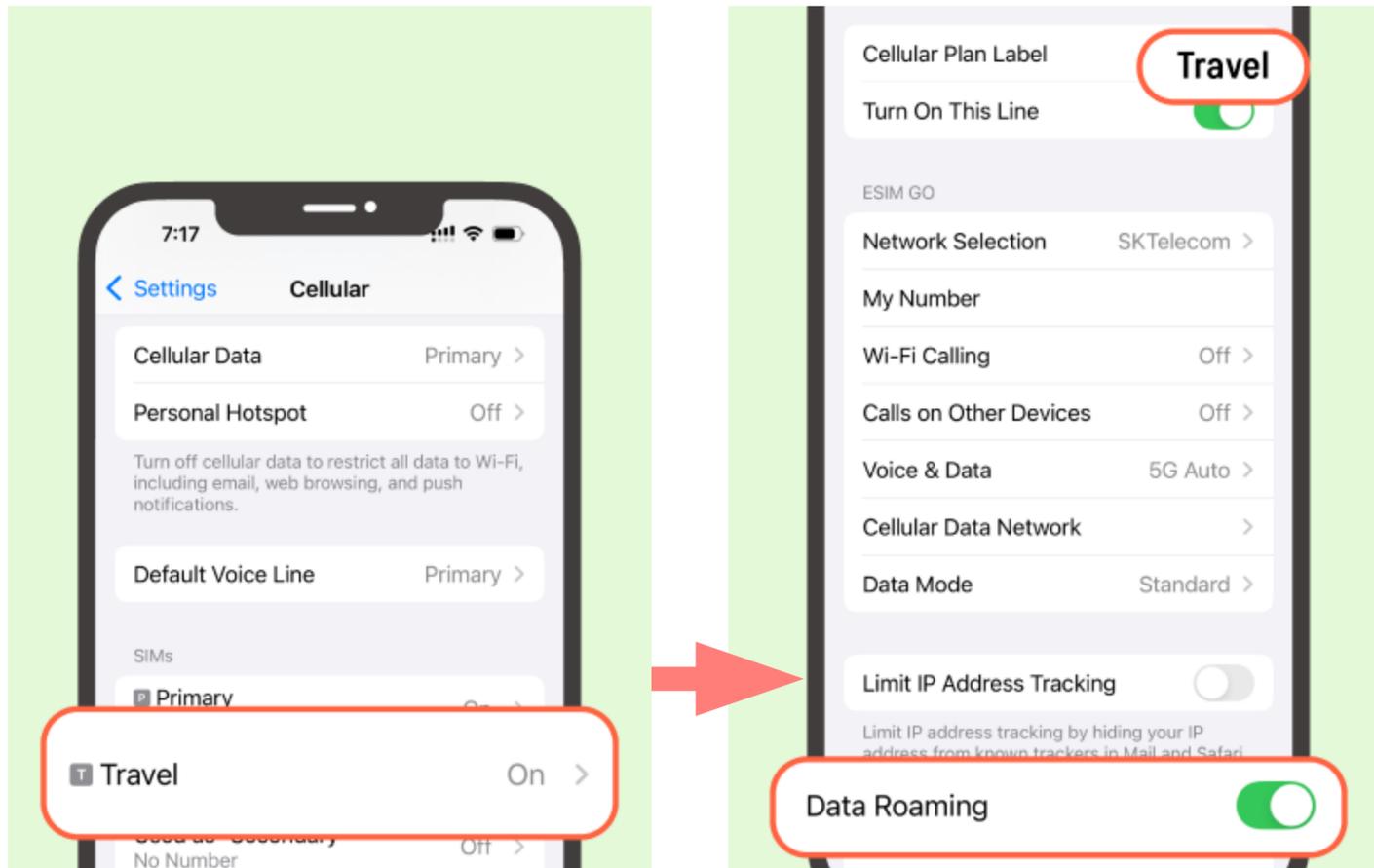
### **3. Settings for local use(Destination)**

- Settings for using eSIM after arriving at your destination
- Settings for **Immediate eSIM Use**

# Local use Settings 1

Cellular > **Travel** > Data Roaming **on**

Cellular > **Primary** > Data Roaming **OFF**



Click '**Travel**'

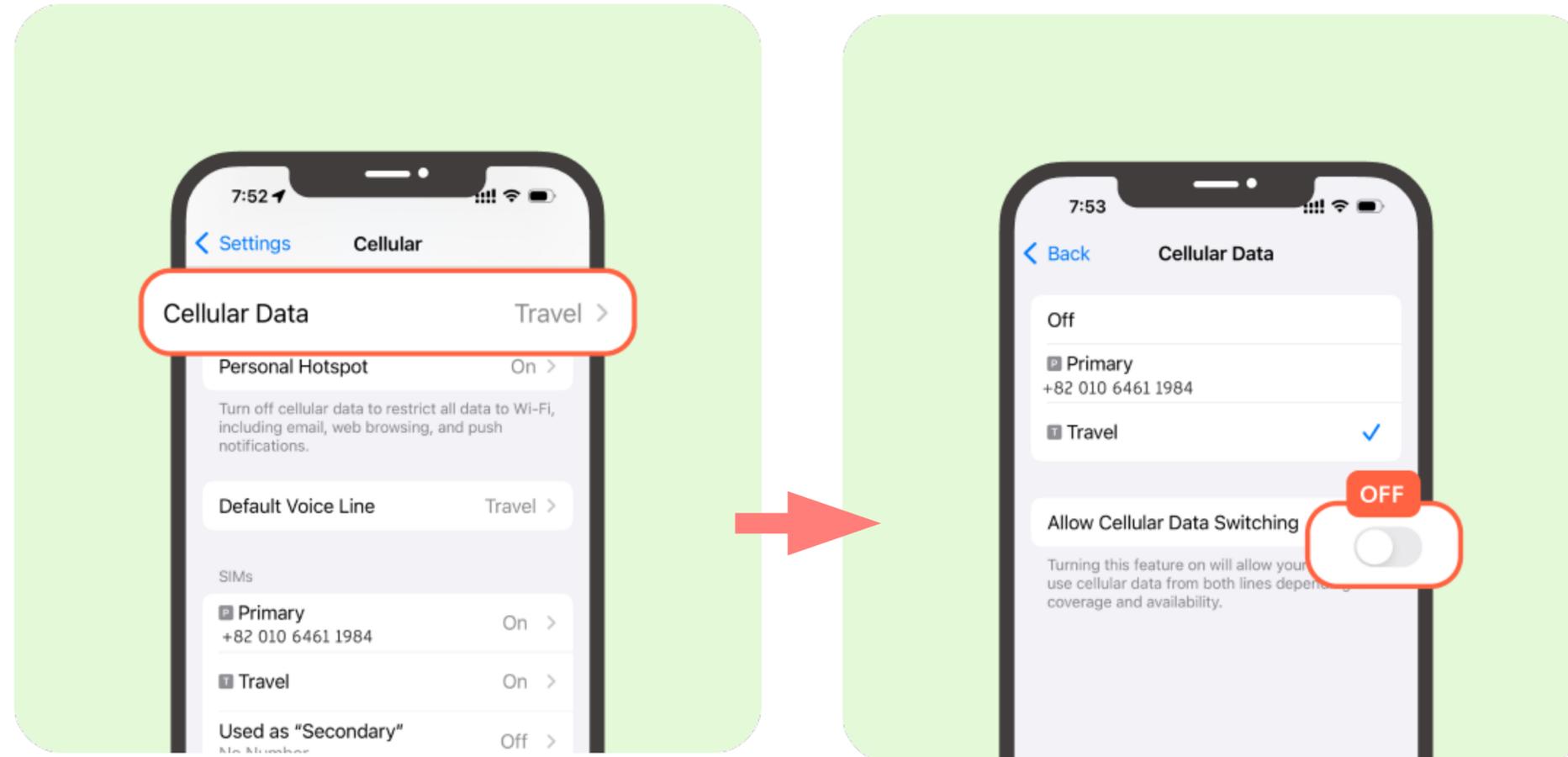
Cellular plan label is '**Travel**' and Set Data Roaming as **On**

Go back and click on '**Primary**'

Cellular plan label is '**Primary**' and Set Data Roaming as **Off**

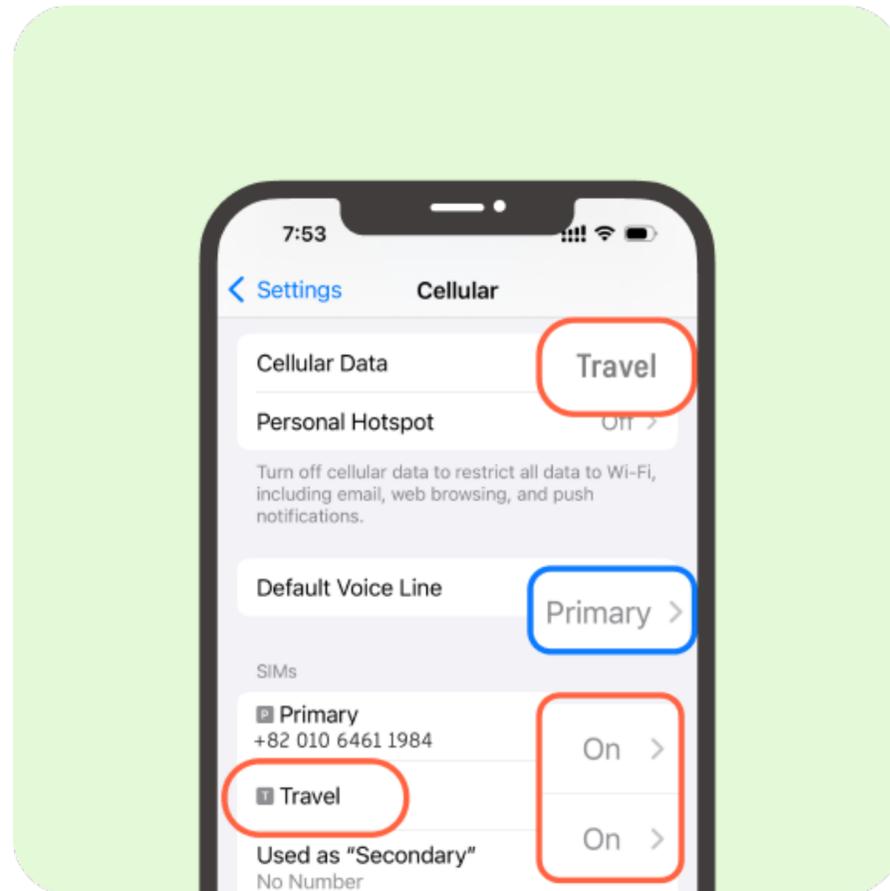
## Local use Settings 2

Cellular > Cellular data > Allow Cellular data switching turn **OFF**



Make sure 'Allow Cellular Data Switching' is turned **OFF** to avoid using data from your existing SIM (carrier plan SIM) and prevent additional data charges.

## Local use Settings 3



1. Confirm that the cellular data and eSIM plan match ('Travel').
2. Set both 'Primary' and 'Travel' to **On**.

### Tip

#### **Calls and messages from your home country while traveling**

Setting your Primary number as the default voice line allows you to receive calls and messages

However, please note that additional charges may apply for incoming and outgoing calls.

### Tip

#### **Contacting friends and families via messaging apps while traveling.**

While traveling, using data messaging apps (such as voice calls, FaceTime, etc.) will not incur additional charges.
